How to Find Volunteers

- 1. Ask for help, this is the most obvious but sometimes the hardest
- 2. Identify passionate participants in the organization and invite them to help
- 3. Personally reach out to potential volunteers
- 4. Ask for volunteers for a specific time, a specific place, & a specific purpose
- 5. Offer a variety of volunteer opportunities, and time commitments
- 6. Ask volunteers to bring along a friend, or two. Volunteering with friends make the 'job' more enjoyable
- 7. Be open and warmly welcome new people
- 8. Listen to new ideas
- 9. Make volunteering easy
- 10. Ask past volunteers for names of potential volunteers to reach out to

How to Retain Volunteers

- 1. Be nice
- 2. Be consistent
- 3. Be honest about time
- 4. Thank the volunteer in person and publicly
- 5. Communicate in a timely manner
- 6. Make a plan of important dates and stick to it
- 7. Burnout is real, give volunteers a break
- 8. Set a goal and be open to how volunteers achieve the tasks
- 9. Appreciate the volunteer for their participation whether it is 10 minutes or 10 hours
- 10. Show volunteers how their volunteerism helps achieve your organization's goals
